Snow Emergencies:

A snow emergency occurs when 2 inches of snow have accumulated. When a snow emergency is in effect, a notification will be sent from the Biglerville Borough office to all residents through our RAVE alert system. If a snow emergency is declared, all vehicles must be removed from the streets to clear the snow.

Snow & Ice Clearing Tips per Borough Ordinance:

- Clear a minimum of 36 inches wide on sidewalk
- Clear all snow & ice within 24 hours after snow or ice has ceased to fall or form
- Sand, salt or abrasive material must be distributed to prevent others from falling
- Do not pile or throw snow onto the street or near a fire hydrant or storm drain
- Pile snow within parking lots, not onto the street
- Products using urea or calcium chloride are less likely to harm sidewalks

Water Information

Service Line Inventory

Biglerville Borough has been testing for lead in homes and businesses throughout the water systems for many years and has remained in compliance with all EPA and PADEP regulations and under the threshold for taking any action regarding lead and copper in the water system. Though Biglerville Borough does not anticipate finding lead service lines in the system, the ruling still requires that information be collected from all water service accounts. It is important to note that even if lead service lines are found this does not mean that our water is contaminated or unsafe to drink. However, we agree in taking this proactive approach to safeguard our community's health.

If you received a letter in November 2024 regarding the service line inventory, please fill out the attached form and return it to the Borough office. We appreciate everyone's help and cooperation in gathering the needed information. The Borough is responsible for submitting the information to DEP.

Backflow Prevention

The Borough is working with NAWSC to complete the backflow prevention program. A backflow prevention device is a means or mechanism to prevent backflow. The basic mechanism for preventing backflow is a mechanical backflow preventer, which provides a physical barrier to backflow. Backflow prevention devices will only allow flow to occur into your home or business and, if operating properly, will never allow flow in the opposite direction (toward the water main). The device does need to be tested by an ASSE-certified technician either annually for commercial or every 5 years for residential.

If you have received a letter about installing a backflow preventer, please call a plumber about getting one installed. If you have any questions, contact the Borough office.

Water Information (Cont.)

East York Street Water Project

The Borough will be conducting a water main replacement project in the Spring of 2025. The project will begin at Square and run under East York Street. The project consists of replacing nearly 3300 lineal feet of antiquated cast iron and transite water main serving the eastern portion of East York Street. It is estimated that the existing water line was installed in the 1930's. Throughout the past few decades, Biglerville Borough has had to maintain and or repair several water line emergency water leaks. The water line upgrade will provide more needed capacity to the residents in this portion of the Borough because the existing water main line is undersized it will also increase reliability of the water main. The expected time frame for this project weather permitting is 6 months. Some residents in the surrounding area of the project will experience water interruptions periodically during the duration of the project. The Borough will notify people in advance of the interruptions. The Borough was awarded multi-year grants for the project. We ask that you be patient during the construction phase process. Anticipate delays during construction.

It's Time to File Your Annual Earned Income Tax Return!

In addition to your state and federal tax returns, if you are not permanently retired or disabled, you are required to file an annual earned income tax return with the York Adams Tax Bureau before April 15 each year. A form must be filed even if you had no earned income. The EIT is levied by both Biglerville Borough and Upper Adams School District. The combined tax rate for residents of Biglerville Borough is 1.6%. EIT taxes W-2 earnings and business net profit.

Beginning in 2025, the York Adams Tax Bureau will no longer mail out Individual Annual or Quarterly Estimated Income Tax Forms. Instead, YATB encourages taxpayers to complete and file their returns online through the Pennsylvania Local Income Tax Exchange (PALite). Go to <u>www.palite.org</u> to file electronically.

In addition, fillable tax forms and information can be found at <u>www.yatb.com</u>, and taxpayers may also bring their tax documents to either of the YATB offices to have their local tax returns prepared free of charge.
