POOL FACTS

Every person owning land on which there is a situated swimming pool, which contains 24 inches or more of water in depth at any point, shall erect and maintain thereon a permanent enclosure not less than four feet in height, capable to being secured against intrusion

- 1. Zoning and Building permits are needed. The Zoning permit is due to land use. The building permit is for an electrical inspection done by MDIA. The cost is \$40.00 for Zoning permit and \$40.00 for building permit. The MDIA costs are not known but can call James and ask him for a price. Their prices are determined by the drawing and what is involved with the inspections.
- 2. Need a drawing with the property's house size, all outside buildings sizes and driveway size. (in order to determine if it's over the maximum lot coverage)
- 3. If the person will be putting up and taking down the pool each year they do not need another zoning permit but will need a new building permit and electrical inspection each year.
- 4. If the pool is 24 to 48 inches in height = they need a fence (according to state rules). If they have a pool that is higher than 48 inches they can use a ladder with a locking device on it, as long as the pool is not attached to any building.
- 5. Above ground pools shall be provided with entrance ways which can be so secured.
- 6. Pool must be located in **rear** of property with a setback of 15 feet. No pool shall be located in any required front or side yard areas.
- 7. Other questions should be checked by Wayne Smith, Code Enforcement Officer
